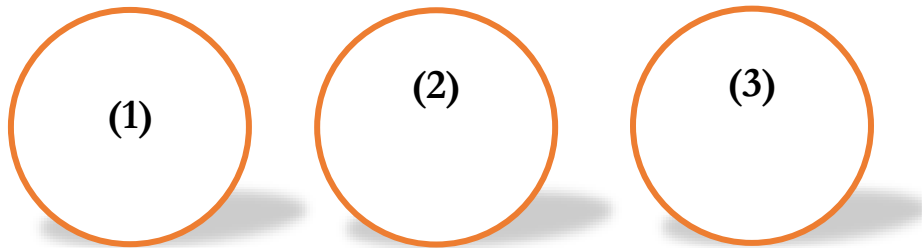


Facilitator Resource 7.1: We Are Connected to a Community That Transcends Time

- Tie a minimum of three knots in a length of twine.
- Cut three or more circles (one circle per knot)
- On one circle write: (1) an elderly relative or ancestor's name, (2) your name, (3) a younger relative's name or a future child's name.



- Hole punch each circle
- On the back of circle (1) and (3) write a short note about the importance of family and how they fit into the generations. Think about all that you have learned.
- On circle (2) write about your current role in the family.
- Affix the circles to the twine in order. You should be in the middle.
